PRESCHOOL TEACHER TRAINING

I have been privileged to work in conjunction with Overland Missions to help initiate preschools in Chief Mukuni's area. During the past four years I have helped to write the Bible and hygiene curriculum for these rural/bush preschools and been in the team of trainers teaching the teachers how to use the curriculum, make their own toys and paint, and whatever else needed to be done. I am one of five team players and count it all joy to work with Jessi, Beverly, Liezl and Christi. They are all amazing women of God and are very gifted teachers and administrators with whom I work.



Soon there will be another area, Chief Nyawa, which will have trained teachers who will be capable of running their community based/supported preschools. I am thankful to God who has allowed me to be involved in such a great ministry project. Reaching children means reaching a family, a community and a country. Imagine, through the existing preschools we reach/teach over 300 children about God and build their basic skills.
